Congratulations to our members at Six Flags. They recently negotiated a new 3 year contracted. I would like to extend special thanks to the Negotiating Committee, consisting of Leo Leos, Sean Elliott and Sergio Perez, for their diligent efforts during the process.

Recently, Randall Pierce, (Business Manager of IBEW Local Union 2337) and I were given letters from the International Office encouraging us to work cooperatively with our respective International Reps to research the viability of consolidating some categories of IBEW represented Units. L.U. 2337 is a Utility Local and its history and focus is in that arena of representation, while L.U. 20 has its roots and focus on construction.

Our Local had two infrastructure based Units (Utility and Phone) which fit Local Union 2337's discipline and template. CenturyLink and Cherokee County Electric Coop have moved from Local Union 20 to Local Union 2337. Those members and contracts will be overseen by Brother Randall Pierce and his office. This loss of 60 members equates to a small loss in L.U. income. Small, because those Units pay a significantly smaller percentage than do Journeyman Wireman for example. However, it did provide our Local the opportunity to become more efficient. After an internal re-shuffle of representatives and assignments we will be able to offset the loss and remain even-to-slightly-better-off financially than we were incurring both the expense and income associated with representing those Units. While those members are now L.U. 2337 members, they are no less our Brothers and Sisters and we wish them and Bro. Pierce well and hope they can continue their relationship for years to come.
