**A Message from Price Warwick, Jr.  
Business Manager/Financial Secretary**

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

For the month of June, we had 63 JIW calls, 40 CE/CW calls, 44 Apprentice calls, and 5 Tele-data calls. There are calls coming in daily, so keep an eye on the jobs board and come get a call. The work picture is picking up and it's looking to be a busy year. We had 7 new members appear and take the oath.

We have made a change to the referral procedure, effective July 1, 2022, upon receiving a third turn down (ding) your name will be rolled to the bottom of the Out of Work List.

The IBEW 40<sup>th</sup> International Convention took place from May 9<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> in Chicago, Illinois. This was an historic convention as it was the first IBEW convention to have a sitting U.S. President address the delegates on the floor of the Convention, and the Fourth District elected the first female Vice President to serve in the IBEW.

The Delegates at the Convention approved increasing the IO Dues by \$2.00 on January 1, 2023, by \$1.00 on July 1, 2024, and by another \$1.00 on July 1, 2025.

The Delegates at the Convention approved increasing the Pension Benefit Fund contribution by \$2.00 on January 1, 2023, and by another \$2.00 on January 1, 2025. The benefit accrual was also increased from \$4.50 to \$5.50 for years of service earned after January 1, 2023 and going forward, accruals earned before January 1, 2023 will remain at \$4.50.

We have voter registration forms and a sworn Registrar here at the hall for anyone needing to get registered see Price III.

The picnic was Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at the Ranch of the Lonesome Dove. There were 247 in attendance who enjoyed the good food, fellowship, games and door prizes.

Remember to keep your dues and death benefits current. Dues are to be paid on the first day of the month to be current for that month. The IBEW Constitution states that no death benefit shall be payable upon the death of a nonretired "A" member if such member is more than (2) two months in arrears in per capita tax payments (dues).
