Dear Brothers and Sisters:

For the month of May, we had 100 JIW calls with 91 filled, 16 CE/CW calls with 16 filled, 22 Apprentice calls filled, and 3 Tele-data calls filled. There are calls going unfilled daily, so keep an eye on the jobs board and come get a call. We signed up 28 new members to the I.B.E.W. in the month. The E Board approved the following pension applications: Eddie Bryant (40), Jesus Villegas (20), and Peter Enbysk (35). May you have a long, healthy, and happy retirement.

Here is the latest update from International Secretary Treasurer Cooper on numbers of COVID cases:

1st District – 211 Cases, 1 death
2nd District – 306 case, 2 deaths, over 200 quarantines
3rd District – 1,857 cases, 22 deaths, 1,388 quarantines
4th District – 2,197 cases, 30 deaths
5th District – 1,321 cases, 7 deaths
6th District – 2,806 cases, 24 deaths, 674 quarantines
7th District – 2,883 cases, 36 deaths, 878 quarantines
8th District – 174 cases, 8 deaths
9th District – 7,157 cases, 34 deaths
10th District – 611 cases, 11 deaths, many quarantines
11th District – 2,526 cases, 5 deaths, many quarantines

We have paid 477 death benefits, however since many death certificates do not include cause of death the number is higher.

We are going to have the General Membership Meeting on Tuesday, July 6th at 7:00 pm with CDC recommended guidelines of mask wearing and social distancing in place to help keep the COVID numbers trend moving in a downward direction.

To limit exposure to the staff and members of the Local Union, we are still limiting the number of people allowed in the building and you must wear a mask and maintain social distancing. We are still open, there is no change to our hours of operation, but the doors will be locked, and we will answer the door individually. We strongly encourage members to conduct any business by mail, email, phone, or online. There is no change to the referral procedure except some days roll call may be held outside to help limit exposure.

If you are a retired A member and receiving a pension from the Pension Benefit Fund your beneficiary will receive a death benefit from the Pension Benefit Fund and, if you are a participant, your beneficiary will receive a death benefit from the Local Union's Death Benefit Fund. Anyone in arrears of death benefits more than one (1) year is considered a non-participant and will not be eligible to receive benefits from the Local Union's Death Benefit Fund.
