# A Message from Price Warwick, Jr. Business Manager/Financial Secretary

For the month of August, we had 61 JIW calls, 14 CE/CW calls, 72 Apprentice calls, and 1 Tele-data call. The calls are picking up, so keep an eye on the jobs board and come get a call. We had 2 new members appear before the membership and take the oath.

On Friday September 30, 2022, Linda Madden-Glenn will be retiring after 37 years of devoted work in the business offices of both Local 59 and Local 20. She has been a valued assistant for the membership all these years and her smiling face will be missed. Drop by Friday and join me in thanking her and wishing her a long and happy retirement.

The Delegates of the 40th IBEW International Convention approved several amendments to Article IX of the IBEW Constitution. Accordingly, effective January 1, 2023, there will be an increase of two dollars (\$2.00) for the per capita that is paid to the General Fund only. There will also be an increase of two dollars (\$2.00) in the IBEW Pension Benefit Fund (PBF) contribution, which applies to "A" members only. The following rates will apply to the international office portion of all monthly dues payments for January 2023, and thereafter:

"A" Members "BA" Members

Per Capita \$22.00 \$22.00

Pension Fund \$21.00 Not Applicable

Total \$43.00 \$22.00

For your reference and information, all the rate changes that were approved at the 40th International Convention are summarized below:

The federal government is preparing to release the \$1.2 trillion Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funds to accomplish the country's most ambitious infrastructure upgrade in decades. To ensure an adequate workforce is available, the Biden-Harris administration has launched a Talent Pipeline Challenge to support employer investments in equitable workforce development for infrastructure jobs. As a participant in the challenge, the IBEW has pledged to reach 10,000 Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program (EVITP) credentialed electricians by August 2022. EVITP is a nationally recognized training standard for installing electric vehicle supply equipment, and the federal government is expected to require the training, which it considers essential to the safe long-term operation and maintenance of the electric vehicle charging infrastructure. This advanced skill program builds on the platform of qualified electricians' extensive knowledge, skills, and

experience, so EVITP certification is easily accomplished for many IBEW journey-level workers, requiring a short, 20-hour course, available through IBEW training centers for \$89.00. The Local Union will reimburse the \$89.00 fee to the first 168 members that receive and present the EVITP certification.

The midterm elections are less than 60 days away, if you need to register or update your registration, we have the forms and a registrar here at the Hall. Enclosed is a list of Labor Friendly Endorsed Candidates for the midterm elections.

The Inside Agreement negotiations will be starting soon.

Anyone interested in helping IBEW members and their families affected by the natural disasters happening recently can go to the Local 20 website and click on the IBEW Unity Fund link to donate.

Remember to keep your dues and death benefits current. Dues are to be paid on the first day of the month to be current for that month. The IBEW Constitution states that no death benefit shall be payable upon the death of a nonretired "A" member if such member is more than (2) two months in arrears in per capita tax payments (dues).
